Alto-Shaam to Manufacture in Mexico

Menomonee Falls, Wisconsin Alto-Shaam has announced plans to establish a manufacturing facility in Saltillo, Coahuila, Mexico. The company is a supplier of commercial kitchen equipment.

Alto- Shaam has contracted with The Offshore Group for 35,000 square feet of industrial space at La Angostura Industrial Park. A first quarter 2007 start-up is planned. Forty workers are expected to be employed at the facility at the projects maturity.
