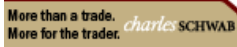

Ducommun Incorporated Announces New Manufacturing Facility in Mexico

LOS ANGELES--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Ducommun Incorporated (NYSE:[DCO](#) - [News](#)) today announced that its Ducommun AeroStructures (DAS) subsidiary has established a subsidiary in Mexico for the production of aircraft structural components and subassemblies for commercial aircraft. DAS has established an office in coordination with The Offshore Group in Mexico, and has signed a long-term lease for a purpose built facility specifically designed to meet its unique production requirements. The facility is located in Guaymas, in the Mexican State of Sonora, approximately five hours south of San Diego on the eastern shore of the Gulf of California. DAS is developing the site to accommodate future expansion of the facility as required to meet the growing needs of the global marketplace and expects to initiate production during the fourth quarter of this year.

titanium, metal bond and composites for a wide variety of military and commercial aerospace applications.


Founded in 1849, Ducommun Incorporated provides engineering and manufacturing services for the aerospace and defense industry.
